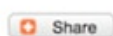
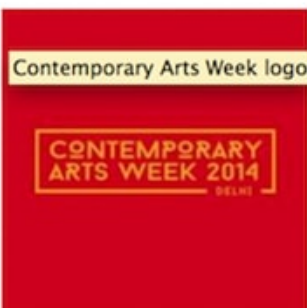


Contemporary Arts Week 2014 in Delhi

The Beauty and The Grit by Roy Campbell-Moore (UK) is an exhibition of small black-framed images by the Scottish dancer-choreographer-artist who is also the founding director of National Dance Company Wales. This is a project with seven dance companies in Wales and India.
